**MICHAEL D. LONG INDUCTED INTO THE SIGMA NU HALL OF HONOR**

**Lexington, Va.** – Sigma Nu Fraternity, Inc., is pleased to announce that Michael D. Long was inducted into the Sigma Nu Hall of Honor on July 18, 2006, in Indianapolis, Ind., during the 62<sup>nd</sup> Grand Chapter (Convention). The Hall of Honor is the highest recognition the Fraternity can bestow on an alumnus.

Over Sigma Nu's 137-year history, only 73 alumni have been inducted into the Hall of Honor. Each inductee must have not only distinguished himself in his respective field, but also rendered distinctive service to the progress and well-being of Sigma Nu Fraternity.

Michael D. Long was initiated into the Epsilon Beta Chapter at Drury University in 1967. Since graduating, Mike remained highly involved on both a local and national level. In 1992, he became an affiliate of the Theta Sigma chapter at Southwest Missouri State University. In 1994, he became the fraternity's 54th Regent (National President), the highest office within the Fraternity. He was most recently honored by the North American Interfraternity Conference Foundation as the 2005 Volunteer of the Year for all Greek Foundations in the nation. He currently serves as the Chairman of the Sigma Nu Educational Foundation and is President of Goose Creek Publishing, a company specializing in making personalized recognition certificates and awards.
